- To qualify, a candidate must score a minimum of 40% marks.
- **Negative marking:** 0.25 mark shall be deducted for every wrong answer.
- The maximum duration of examination will be 100 minutes.

Step 3: Typing Proficiency Test:

- A Typing Proficiency Test shall be conducted separately in Punjabi and English on a computer.
- For the Punjabi Typing Test, candidates shall be required to type the passage in Unicode Compliant Raavi Font. The Punjabi passage shall be composed of characters from the Gurmukhi alphabet, Gurmukhi and English numerals, and punctuation marks. Candidates shall be required to type the text exactly as provided in the passage.
- The duration of each typing test, i.e. Punjabi and English, shall be 10 minutes. An interval of 15 minutes shall be provided between the two language tests.
- To qualify the Typing Proficiency Test, a candidate shall be required to achieve a minimum gross typing speed of 30 words per minute (w.p.m.) in both Punjabi and English. Candidates shall be permitted a maximum of 8% mistakes in each language test separately.
- A candidate who commits more than 8% mistakes or fails to achieve the prescribed minimum gross typing speed of 30 words per minute in either language test shall be deemed to have failed the Typing Proficiency Test.
- A candidate must qualify both the Punjabi and English Typing Proficiency Tests; failure to qualify in either test shall render the candidate ineligible for inclusion in the merit list.
- The Typing Proficiency Test shall be of qualifying nature only, and the marks obtained therein shall not be counted towards the final merit.

Step 4: Preparation of merit

Note: Candidates qualifying in Exam-II will be called to appear for the Shorthand Proficiency Test.

Step 3: Shorthand Proficiency Test:

- A Shorthand Proficiency Test shall be conducted separately in English and Punjabi.
- In each language, candidates shall be required to take dictation at a speed of 80 words per minute and transcribe the same at a speed of 15 words per minute.
- The dictation passage shall consist of 400 words, divided into two paragraphs of 200 words each.
- Candidates shall be permitted a maximum of 8% mistakes in each language test separately.
- A candidate who commits more than 8% mistakes in either language test shall be deemed to have failed the Shorthand Proficiency Test.
- A candidate must qualify both the English and Punjabi Shorthand Proficiency Tests; failure to qualify in either test shall render the candidate ineligible for inclusion in the merit list. Marks shall be counted towards the final merit.
- Marks for the qualified candidates shall be awarded as follows:

Step 4: Preparation of merit

- Scrutiny of application forms/documents shall be carried out after conduct of above steps for candidates qualifying the prescribed steps 1 to 3. Eligibility shall be determined as on the last date of submission of applications.

- 2) A merit list shall be prepared as per the following scorecard, and uploaded on the university website:

- 3) In case of tie in the merit:
1. Candidate older in age shall be ranked higher.
 2. If tie still persists, candidate securing higher percentage of marks in Graduation shall be ranked higher.
 3. If tie still persists, candidate securing higher percentage of marks in Matriculation Examination shall be ranked higher.

Step 5: Document Verification: A suitable number of Candidates will be called for document verification as per the final merit list. Candidate must prove his/her eligibility by producing original documents during document verification.

Note:

- 1) The decision of the University regarding eligibility, conduct of examination, evaluation and selection shall be final.
- 2) Only candidates qualifying all prescribed stages shall be considered for selection.
- 3) Mere appearance in examination / document verification shall not confer any right to selection.
- 4) Use of unfair means / misconduct during examination or recruitment process shall lead to cancellation of candidature and legal action, wherever required.
